



CHYK is the youth wing of Chinmaya Mission, where young adults are taught to channel their dynamic spirit and energy towards selfless service, devotion to Bhagavan, and study of spiritual texts.

CHYK West is honored to present to you information regarding the 2023 Youth Empowerment Program (YEP). YEP is a Chinmaya Mission initiative through which young adults have the opportunity to live in an ashram setting for two months, where they will be exposed to the realm of Vedanta and its practical messages for a fulfilling life.

Through the grace and blessings of Pujya Gurudev, Pujya Guruji, and Pujya Swami Swaroopanandaji, the seventh batch of YEP America will be conducted at Chinmaya Mangalam in Barry, Texas. During the program, students will have the opportunity to explore various Vedantic scriptures in depth, such as introductory texts written by Bhagavan Adi Shankaracharyaji, the Bhagavad Gita, and the Upanishads, learning directly from teachers of Chinmaya Mission. YEP will also include activities and workshops in order to facilitate inner growth, teach essential life skills, build moral values, and inspire the participants to serve society with an attitude of humility and compassion. Students leave YEP with heightened self-confidence and mindfulness, a strong support system of friends and mentors, and a commitment to the pursuit of true happiness and knowledge.

Registration for YEP 2023 has officially opened — the program will be conducted from June 5 – July 25, 2023. We encourage you to pass on this information to young adults in your centers and community who would be good candidates for this program. YEP is not limited to individuals who have participated in Balavihar – all young adults aged 18–28 who are interested in studying Vedanta and benefit from this program are encouraged to apply. 



Chinmaya Inspirational Yatra XV: Bharat Yatra














The 15th Chinmaya Inspirational Yatra from Niagara travelled to Bharat with 35 yatris for 15 days. For a few, it was the first visit to our motherland. The journey was immaculately organized by Vijayji and Vivekji. As the idea of this yatra was conceived in the Ramcharitramanas class, there was special focus on Ayodhya and Prayagraj. We also paid homage in Shri Krishna's Holy cities of Vrindhavan, Mathura and Gokul. The last of Shri Krishna's leela site was Govardhan parikrama done by e-Rickshaw. The yatris were then hosted by Chinmaya Mission Prayagraj Ashram. Pujya Swami Gangeshanandaji gave us the everlasting knowledge of purushartha as a true bhakta from Bhagvatam. Brni Shashwati Chaitanya also gave discourses on Bharat's devotion to Lord Rama in Ayodhakanda (Ramcharitramanas). Immersed in Bhakti marg, the Yatris then experienced miracles of Guru Kripa. The vatris were able to get onto the construction site of the Ramjanmabhoomi temple. It was a highly emotionally visit, where we were guided by a true bhakta (like Shri Hanuman) working tirelessly without monetary reward in the development of this holy site. Whilst in Prayagraj, the yatris visited several holy sites and enjoyed the waters of triveni sangam. The major highlight was performing abhishekam for Mahashivaratri in the Shiva temple of Prayagraj ashram. Usually, a selected few are given an opportunity to do so in the Shiva temple. However, as miracles go, 9 Shivalinga sets from mud were set up with a pundit and each of the yatris had opportunity to do the pooja within the temple. The yatra concluded with a visit to Kasi Vishwanath temple and Ganga arti. Those who were blessed to be in this trip offer their humble gratitude to the Guru-shishya-parampara.


#### **Key Takeaway from Meaningful Mornings:**
